Beginning Season 2022: Hunter Derbies, Jumper Derbies, Relays and Equitation Classics will be awarded 1.5 points toward the matching SNHSA division. This does not apply to the SNHSA Medal Finals. All of these classes require a special declaration form for points to be awarded.

This completed form allows points earned in a special class not directly affiliated with a SNHSA sanctioned division to be directed to the specific SNHSA sanctioned division for year-end points. See the points allocations allowable below.

SPECIAL JUMPER CLASS POINTS ALLOCATIONS ALLOWABLE

Points may be earned for jumper classes with corresponding Division jump heights.

Exception:
If the special jumper class is at 2'9" the following divisions are eligible for points allocation:

- Level 1 Jumpers, Low Child/Adult Amateur Jumpers

SPECIAL EQUITATION CLASS POINTS ALLOCATIONS ALLOWABLE

Points may be earned for special Equitation classes and will be allocated to the rider's age-appropriate Equitation division.

SPECIAL HUNTER CLASS POINTS ALLOCATIONS ALLOWABLE

If the special hunter class is **at or below 2'3"** the following divisions are eligible for points allocation:

- Pony Hunters, Long/Short Stirrup, Mini Hunters

If the special hunter class is **at 2'6"** the following divisions are eligible for points allocation:

- Special Hunters, Modified Child/Adult Hunters

If the special hunter class is **2'9" or above** the following divisions are eligible for points allocation:

- Low Hunters, Children's/Adult Amateur Hunters, Modified Open Hunters
